<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 230</b>	Requires public schools to stock menstrual products in 3rd and 4th Grade girls' bathrooms and at least one boys' bathroom.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>76-0-4</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 541</b>	Requires all public high schools to provide condoms free of charge, plus allows handing them out in 7th grade health class.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>65-11-4</b>	VETOED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 1078</b>	Prevents school boards from saying "no" to or removing LGBTQ+ or Critical Race Theory curriculum or books.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>61-17-2</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 760</b>	Requires one all-gender restroom in every public school. It could be a single-stall bathroom or a multi-stall bathroom.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>65-6-9</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 596</b>	Criminalizes speaking in a way that makes school personnel feel "seriously alarmed" or causes them "emotional distress."	<b>PASS</b>	<b>65-8-7</b>	VETOED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 5</b>	Mandates teacher training on how to affirm LGBTQ+ identities in students and how to identify non-LGBTQ+ affirming parents.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>65-0-15</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 665</b>	Enables minors 12 & older to consent to counseling or a state-funded group home without parental knowledge or permission.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>60-16-4</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 571</b>	Requires insurance companies to sell doctors malpractice insurance at standard rates for trans-surgeries & drugs for minors.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>64-14-2</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 270</b>	Prohibits suspension of pupils enrolled in any of grades 6 to 8, for disrupting school activities or otherwise willfully defying the valid authority of supervisors, teachers, administrators, school officials, or other school personnel engaged in the performance of their duties to all grades, by 4 years to instead be until July 1, 2029, commencing July 1, 2024	<b>PASS</b>	<b>61-13-6</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 70</b>	Requires mandatory kindergarten for all children in the state of California.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>59-12-19</b>	ENROLLED

<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 2098</b>	Amended the Business & Professions Code to make it unprofessional conduct for a physician or surgeon to disseminate "misinformation" about covid19. Meaning refusal to go along with the narrative	<b>PASS</b>	<b>56-20-4</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 659</b>	Mandates all Students be Vaccinated against HPV (A sexually transmitted disease)	<b>PASS</b>	<b>60-13-7</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 1666</b>	Prohibits Recognition of Out-of-State Abortion Lawsuits as contrary to State public policy: and prohibit the enforcement or satisfaction of a civil judgment received under that law.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>56-15-7</b>	ENROLLED

<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 1327</b>	Authorizes Individuals to Sue Firearm Manufactures	<b>PASS</b>	<b>52-21-7</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 2156</b>	Establishes New Requirements for Firearm Manufacturers - prohibits person, firm, or corporation from manufacturing more than three firearms in CA in a year unless properly licensed; requires reporting of manufacturers who cease operations; makes violation a misdemeanor.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>54-16-8</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 2</b>	Amends Penal Code Related to Firearms - repeals good character and good cause from issuance requirements, specifies individual is disqualified if they are a danger to themselves or others or the community at large	<b>PASS</b>	<b>54-23-3</b>	ENROLLED

<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 385</b>	Lowers abortion safety standards by letting physician assistants perform abortions without doctor oversight.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>58-15-7</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 345</b>	Protects doctors fleeing to CA after doing illegal abortions and trans-surgeries on minors in other states.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>62-15-3</b>	ENROLLED

<b>AYE</b>	<b>AB 223</b>	Allows minors, with parental permission, to legally change the sex identifier on their legal documents and keep the change secret.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>64-8-8</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 447</b>	Starts a marketing campaign to promote LGBTQ+ ideology in conservative states with laws considered "anti-LGBTQ+."	<b>PASS</b>	<b>64-12-4</b>	ENROLLED
<b>AYE</b>	<b>SB 407</b>	Requires all foster parents to promise to affirm their foster children's identities if they decide to identify as LGBTQ+.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>61-14-5</b>	ENROLLED

<b>AYE</b>	<b>HR 57</b>	A resolution to declare the month of August each year as Transgender History Month.	ADOPTED

<b>ABS</b>	<b>ACA 5</b>	Constitutional Amendment to repeal the traditional definition of marriage (Proposition 8) from the CA Constitution.	<b>PASS</b>	<b>67-0-13</b>	PROPOSITION
